



### **ROGER D. POLLARD**

*(Deceased 3 December 2011)*

Roger Pollard was born in London, England in 1946. He received his technical education, graduating with the degrees of BSc and PhD in Electrical and Electronic Engineering, at the University of Leeds, Leeds, UK.

Until September 2010, Roger was Professor and Dean of Engineering at the University of Leeds where he had been a faculty member since 1974. Starting in 1981, he also was a consulting engineer at Agilent Technologies/ Hewlett Packard, Santa Rosa, CA where he worked on the next generation of network analyzers. Throughout his career, he made significant research contributions to microwave and millimeter-wave circuits, network measurements, calibration and error correction, terahertz technology and large-signal characterization. He authored technical contributions in books, over 150 journal articles, 3 patents and company and commercial publications.

Roger was elected to the UK's national academy, the Royal Academy of Engineering, in 2005. He was honored as an IEEE Fellow and a Chartered Engineer and Fellow of the IET (formerly the IEE).

#### **DESCRIPTION OF ACCOMPLISHMENT(S) RELATIVE TO THE CREATION, DEVELOPMENT, OR ADVANCEMENT OF THE TECHNICAL OBJECTIVES OF THE IEEE:**

As Chair of the TAB/PAB Electronic Products Committee, Roger provided the leadership for the creation and launch of IEEE-*Xplore*, a world-class resource of technical information. In addition to expanding the reach of IEEE/TAB technical content, this has developed into the largest source of revenue for IEEE/TAB. This grew from an activity he initiated with IEEE Microwave Theory and Techniques Society periodical and conference materials in the mid-1990s.

During his terms as PSPB Strategic Planning Chair, Roger led the development of the Publication Services and Products Board Strategic Plan articulating the goal for IEEE to be the world's leader in technology information, offering a vision for continued transformation to meet the evolving needs of IEEE's members and customers. This included some of the earliest strategic thinking concerning IEEE's role in and use of Open Access.

During his term as TAB-VP, Roger initiated closer relations between TAB Societies and the other major boards – in particular with MGA. This led to a greater role of Technical Activities and Societies in the tri-annual MGA Sections Congress in 2011 and to discussions related to the expansion of society membership to a great portion of the IEEE membership.

As an individual, Roger set an exceptional example of leadership and collegial interaction, to which all future TAB members should aspire.
